

What is the volunteering programme about?

DAP is going Rural and we need you! We are inviting Malaysians who are 18 years old and above to be part of our Impian Sarawak campaign.

What am I required to do?

Your strength is needed! We will need to provide physical labour and work alongside the local villagers to complete the infrastructure projects. You will also have an opportunity to meet with and learn from local villagers who still practice a traditional way of life.

When is the project happening?

There will be a series of projects in rural Sarawak for the next few years under Impian Sarawak. We will update the project dates as and when we have confirmed the exact details of the project.

Where is the kampung located?

We will update the exact location of the village once the project is confirmed.

Do I need to be a Malaysian to join?

Yes, this programme is only extended to Malaysian citizens.

Do I need to pay to volunteer?

Yes, this programme is fully self-supported by the volunteers themselves. There will be a contribution fee and this will cover your return transportation from airport to the kampung walking entrance, homestay in the village, insurance and all food expenses. Contribution fee is project specific, and we will update once the project has been confirmed.

What other expenses do I need to consider?

A return flight ticket to Kuching which will cost between RM100-RM300.

What do I need to bring?

We will update the details to you individually once we have confirmed your participation.

What are the living conditions like?

You will be living in basic condition, with minimal electricity supply (from generator), and water may be scarce during dry season.

Will I be safe?

We will take all necessary precaution to ensure that safety measure is observed at all times. Your safety is our priority.

Is there phone signal in the village?

Phone signal is limited in the village, and only in certain areas.

What is the deadline for application?

This is an ongoing recruitment for volunteers to be part of the Impian Sarawak Outreach Projects. We need as many volunteers that we can get to work together to make the projects happen!

Can I use this opportunity to fulfill community project criteria with my college / university?

Yes, you can add this experience into your CV / resume but we won't be responsible to provide any signatures / recommendations / verification.

Do I need to know how to speak BM?

BM is widely used in the village. However, most of them do understand basic English.
